



# EEC Return to Ice Guidelines

Updated October 23, 2020

## Entering/Exiting the Facility

- ▶ Enter through lower level doors. Exit through back emergency exit in stairwell. Follow signage posted.
- ▶ Users will get access to the facility 15 minutes prior to an ice rental. Doors will be locked 5 minutes after your ice session begins. Once the doors are locked, no parents are to enter until the next scheduled changeover (15 mins prior to the next ice session). **PARENTS ARE NOT TO LET OTHER PARENTS INTO THE FACILITY.**
- ▶ ALL Users **MUST** wear a mask inside the building. This includes standing on the rail or sitting with your child(ren). Users can only remove the mask when on the ice (physical activity).
- ▶ Screening/Contact tracing. All users groups are **required** to complete contact screening for each rental. Private rental groups can complete a single form for the entire group. Participants in public sessions must complete individual COVID-19 declarations online or upon arrival. Forms can be found at [www.clareville.ca](http://www.clareville.ca)
- ▶ 1 parent per user (Under 12 years of age) are permitted in the facility. Additional siblings can accompany parents, if necessary, but all parties **MUST** sit in the designated seating area (section 5).
- ▶ Parents are not permitted in the dressing room area.
- ▶ No access to seating area for individual parents. Standing room only. Seating area is to be used by parents with additional siblings only.
- ▶ Maximum of 100 people permitted inside at any given time. This includes users on the ice surface, staff, spectators, etc.
- ▶ Walking Track will be open Monday to Friday. 6:15 am to 2:00 pm.

## Ice Activity

- ▶ Maximum of 35 users on the ice surface at any given time. Including coaches.
- ▶ Minimum of 15 minutes between rentals for sanitizing high touch areas.
- ▶ Dressing room access will be permitted with physical distancing measures in place. Access to showers will be available with restrictions.
- ▶ Users will have access to the bench area.
- ▶ Chairs in be placed in hallway for groups who do not require a dressing room. Marked for physical distancing.
- ▶ No congregating inside the facility (includes lobby, meeting rooms, etc.)
- ▶ No access to the penalty box (This includes music access. Bluetooth technology is available from outside the penalty box for music requirements. Users must have their own playlists).

## Hygiene/Sanitization

- ▶ These areas will be sanitized regularly between each user group:
  - Seats in corridor, bench area, door handles, rail along spectator standing area, section 5 seating area, dressing rooms benches, showers, any other high touched surface.

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
