



# Public Skating Guidelines

- Users will enter through lower level doors. Exit through back emergency exit in stairwell.
- Doors will be opened 15 minutes before the scheduled skating session.
- ALL users **MUST** wear a mask inside the building. Users can remove the mask when on the ice.
- ALL Skaters **MUST** register online using the Clarenville Active Living Registration Form prior to attending a skating session. It's free and easy. Register here: <https://studiobookingsonline.com/clarenvilleactiveliving> (If applicable, skating admission will be collected at the EEC upon arrival).
- No spectators permitted. One parent/guardian can accompany skaters below 12 years of age. Parents **MAY** bring other siblings if necessary. Parent/siblings not participating in skating **MUST** sit in an assigned seat for the duration of the skating session. Parents with no additional siblings **MUST** stand near the rail on the upper walking track area.
- Maximum of **35 users** on the ice surface at any given time.
- Skaters cannot congregate at the players benches or any other area.
- Users will get access to dressing rooms, which are marked for physical distancing.
- Upon completion of the session, users will have **15 minutes** to remove skates and exit the building.
- Helmets are **MANDATORY** for all skaters
