RECYCLING GUIDELINES

The Town of Clarendville curbside collection services includes curbside recycling collection for residents. You can take advantage of this service by gathering your recyclables, sorting them and placing them in blue recycling bags at your curb every second week on your assigned garbage collection day.

PREPARING YOUR RECYCLABLES:

- 1** Sort recyclables into two groups: Paper products and Containers



- 2** Place all paper products together in clear blue recycling bags (separate from containers)



- 3** Ensure all containers are rinsed then placed together in clear blue recycling bags (separate from paper products)



Please Note: Loose cardboard will not be collected

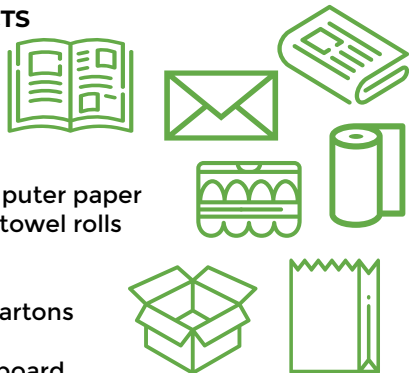
